

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST TO LOCAL COUNCILS

TRADITIONAL STONEMASONRY / CONSERVATION 1 & 2 DAY COURSES

Traditional stonemasonry / conservation courses have been run since 2009 by Applied Building Conservation Training. The course, illustrated by lectures and practical examples, the manner in which the conservation repair of historical building can be achieved. The methods demonstrated include those evolved and approved by the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) and the Department of Environment, Water and Natural Resources (DEWNR). The convenor, Keith McAllister (ABC Training), is a qualified conservator with long experience in this field of work, and will provide the participants with the following hands-on experience:

- Principles of repair and conservation
- Techniques in stone and brick conservation
- Understanding lime mortar and its use in repair
- Salt damp remediation
- Theoretical and practical experience in artisan trades.

ABC Training has recently successfully completed these courses with the Alexandrina Council, Onkaparinga Council and Central Darling Shire Council NSW.



These courses may be eligible for relevant funding resources through the provision of assistance in promoting sound heritage conservation and management. South Australian local Councils are encouraged to negotiate avenues for funding.

The venues to be worked on are generally a significant building of State or Local interest, supplied by Councils and/or State owned heritage listed buildings.

Participants and course convening fees will be provided upon request.

ABC Training has an existing data base of previous course attendees, however local Councils are encouraged to promote these workshops with known local tradespeople, heritage owners, architects, surveyors, urban and policy planners, structural engineers, heritage advisors and similarly aligned stakeholders.
